Required to measure and lay off according to Law six Hundred and
forty Acres of Land for Jacob Brown, on Holchuckey River at
the Mouth of Chonokee Creek including an Island in s^d River
and running up and down for Compliment Above and below the
mouth of s^d Creek for Compliment. Purchased in open Treaty
of the Cherokee Indians, in the Year 1775. The said Treaty being
held on the said Land. given under my hand this 22nd of April 1778
